The Board of Trustees of the Wink-Loving Independent School District convened in **special** monthly session at 6:00 p.m., August 30, 2011 in the administration board room.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION	None
MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING	Minutes from August 11 were presented to the board members for their approval. Trustee Halterman made the motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes and accept them as presented. Trustee Hotze seconded the motion and it passed with a unanimous vote.
BUDGET AMENDMENTS	Holly Bryan, Business Manager, went over the budget amendments with the board members. In fund 199, Student Attendance Credits; were over budget \$1,199,770.00. The new budget amount is \$10,199,770.00 Holly reported that we had additional revenue of \$1,310,357.72 We were \$272,785.77 under budget for the 2010-2011 school year. Motion made by Trustee Antley and seconded by Trustee White to approve the budget amendments as presented.
FINANCIAL REPFORTS BILLS PAYABLE AND BILLS PAID	Holly Bryan went over the final bills for the month of August to close out this fiscal year. The bills totaled \$ 35,743.81. After paying the bills, we have \$ 2,612,611.37 in the bank. Motion made by Trustee White to approve the reports and pay the bills for August. Motion seconded by Trustee Halterman and passed with a unanimous vote.

SUPER- INTENDENT'S	Mr. Benham told the board members that he is waiting on video for them to view on their own.
REPORTS	Scotty Carman said there are 220 kids enrolled in Elementary for the first
	week of school. 38 of those students are in Kindergarten. We have a total of
	360 students enrolled for the school year for all grades.
	We will host Open House on Thursday, September 1 from 6-8 p.m.

ACTION ITEMS REPAY INSURANCE ACCOUNT FUNDS	Mr. Benham told the board members he would like to repay the insurance account funds in the amount of \$500,000.00 since we have a good fund balance at the end of this fiscal year. Motion made by Trustee Antley to approve repaying the insurance account funds as recommended by Mr. Benham. Motion seconded by Trustee Halterman and passed with a unanimous vote.
NOVATE TITLE III, PART A, LEP FUNDS TO REGION 18	<ul><li>Mr. Benham said we need to novate Title III, Part A, LEP Fund to Region 18.</li><li>\$903 is the Title III, Part A, LEP amount.</li><li>Motion made by Trustee Halterman to novate the funds as recommended by Mr. Benham.</li><li>Motion seconded by Trustee Slaughter and passed with a unanimous vote.</li></ul>
PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX RATE	There were no local citizens present for the public meeting. Mr. Benham reviewed the highlights of the budget and the tax rate as well as expected recapture amounts for the board members. The board members have had their budget books for over a week to review prior to this meeting. No motion on this item; it is just the public meeting.
APPROVE 2011- 2012 BUDGET	Our 2011-2012 values are: Winkler County, \$549,052,389 and Loving County, \$705,857,630 for a total combined value of \$1,254,910,019.00 Projected Levy will be \$13,051,064.20. Motion made by Trustee Slaughter to approve the budget for 2011-2012 year. Motion seconded by Trustee Antley and passed with a unanimous vote.
ADOPT THE 2011 TAX RATE BY RESOLUTION	Mr. Benham told the board members the 2011 tax rate will be \$1.04/\$100 and recommended approval of the tax rate by resolution. Mr. Benham had already reviewed the projected levy for the year that we anticipate receiving. Motion made by Trustee Antley to approve the tax rate as recommended. Motion seconded by Trustee Slaughter and passed with a unanimous vote.

## RESOLUTION

Providing for the imposition of a property tax and setting a tax rate

WHEREAS, the Wink-Loving Independent School District is a lawfully organized political subdivision of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Wink-Loving Independent School District is empowered to levy taxes by Section 23.23, Texas Education Code; and;

WHEREAS, all prerequisites of law for the imposition of a property tax and the adoption of a tax rate have been performed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Wink-Loving Independent School District that an ad valorem property tax be hereby levied against the district's 2011 appraisal roll, which tax shall be and is hereby levied at the rate of \$1.04000 per \$100.00 of assured valuation, with \$1.04000 being allocated to the Operating Fund.
